### Flu Immunisation

All children have the opportunity to receive the flu vaccine at Garnteg School on October 5<sup>th</sup>. Information has been sent out to pupils and signed letters have been returned to school Please ensure your letter is brought in on Monday if you are yet to return it.

Here is some Information from NHS Wales.

Vaccine preventable diseases can cause serious illness and complications. Vaccination is the best and safest way to protect the child and others from flu, which is extremely important this year to avoid a flu epidemic on top of the recent Covid 19 pandemic. The Chief Medical Officer in Wales has stressed the importance of ensuring children receive their immunisations during the Covid crisis period to avoid outbreaks of other diseases.

Nurses will follow compliance with government guidelines and schools' arrangements when giving the Vaccine on Monday and full PPE and risk assessments have been completed.
