Important - changes to arrangements for Wednesday Afternoons

Until further notice on <u>Wednesday afternoons</u> classes 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 11 & 12 will be collected as follows:

School resumes to online learning with the exception of all bus pupils who will remain in school along with exceptional circumstances for Critical Care Workers, who have pre-arranged prior to 8th March.

<u>Starting week commencing 19th April 2021 Classes 1, 2, 9, 10, 13 and 14</u> will remain in school on Wednesday afternoons so are not affected.

Also, from Monday 26th April the Millennium Hall car park will be open to parents for us to apply the correct walking routes and control of social mixing. Teachers will also be asking for names of pupils whose parents will be using this carpark as school staff will need to be deployed to meet the children by opening the second bottom gate entrance. Therefore, the school will need to give parents a separate time for those wishing to use it and to be included on our track and trace (if needed if you do not plan to walk children up to the main entrance). Existing Nursery and Foundation Phase users with siblings will continue to use this. Unfortunately, parents will not be able to swap between the entrances on different days.

If your child is tested for Covid 19, we will need proof of the negative result <u>before</u> your child is able to return to school. Please email the result to garnteg.school.office@torfaen.gov.uk.
