

Cashless Catering and Education Payment Portal

In June last year Torfaen LA & Catering set up a new system for payment of school meals, school activities and trips etc.

Message to parents from Civica Education payments

We are aware that schools have reported problems with parents not being able to make payments using Civica Education Payments. This is down to a new mandatory security feature for online payments which was switched on recently by the banks. It is difficult to provide parents with specific advice, because banks who issue cards all have different ways of authenticating their customers. For example, you may be asked for an additional measure of authentication via a text message, email or via an app. Not all transactions required this additional authentication.

Our advice to parents is to keep trying as payments should eventually go through.
