COVID GUIDANCE FROM 08.04.22 ONWARDS INTO THE SUMMER TERM

The separate Covid guidelines for schools, colleges, and special schools remain in place. The next three-week review of Covid regulations will take place around the 14th April and we will write to you if and when there are any further changes.

The following core measures should remain in place to protect learners and staff:

- All staff and learners should be reminded to follow the <u>Welsh Government</u> guidance for self-isolation.
- Staff and learners should not attend school if they have any COVID-19 symptoms. If a staff member or learner becomes symptomatic, they should get a test as soon as possible and should self-isolate until the outcome of the test. Further guidance is available from the Welsh Government website.
- Regular handwashing, and respiratory etiquette (Catch it, Bin it, Kill it) are key interventions to prevent spread and manage cases, incidents & outbreaks.

Cost of Living Support Payment

A £150 cost of living payment is to be made to all occupiers of properties that are in bands A, B, C and D, along with those that receive council tax reduction (formerly known as council tax benefit), regardless of what band their property is in (A to I).

You do not need to make a claim if you pay by direct debit - it will be paid to the account holder automatically.
