Children are invited to wear Christmas jumper, costumes or something sparkly.




Parent Workshops

We have organized two workshops for parents/carers in January 2024. The first one is a well-being workshop for parents, and the second one is a workshop to help your child learn to read. In

the reading workshop, we will teach you about the reading methods we use at Garnteg to help your child improve their reading skills. This session will be 90 minutes for parents then 30 minutes with your child(ren) to put what you have learnt into practice. This workshop is open to parents/carers of Nursery to Year 2 students only and will take place over six weeks.

The well-being workshop will take place over four weeks and is open to parents of all-year groups. The workshop will be held on Thursdays from 3:15 pm to 4:15 pm.
