



Congratulations to the Early Years, Flying Start Team at Little Duckling's Playgroup Garnteg, who were recently inspected by Care Inspectorate Wales and were given the report of excellence. Well done to the team who thoroughly deserve the recognition for all their hard work and dedication to all the children and families they work with.

Parking Enforcement

From Monday 3rd November, a new mobile enforcement car will be used to enforce parking restrictions helping to improve road safety outside schools.

The vehicle is fitted with CCTV which will record footage of cars parked in contravention of a restriction outside schools, as well as in bus stops or on zig zag lines.

A two-week warning period will start from Monday 3rd November, when any vehicle captured parked in contravention will receive a automatic warning notice in the post.

Full enforcement will begin on Monday 17^{th} November, when any drivers parked in the excluded areas will be sent automatic penalty charge notices. The penalty notice charges will be £70, this can be reduced by 50% if paid within 14 days.

The council is keen to warn parents of the camera enforcement vehicle and encourage them to park safely and responsibly to avoid being issued with a Penalty Charge Notice.

It is hoped the camera enforcement vehicle - together with our Civil Enforcement team - will help to ensure drivers park safely and responsibly, which will make the environment around schools safer for all road users.

Please can the school entrance always be always kept clear including outside of school hours.
