

### Children and Young Persons' £1 Bus Travel Scheme


From 1st September 2025, the Welsh Government introduced cheaper bus tickets for 16 - 21-year-olds with a MyTravel pass in Wales and some cross border services.

From 3 November 2025, the £1 single bus fare and £3 day ticket will be extended to 5 - 15-year-olds in Wales and some cross border services. 5 - 15-year-olds don't need a MyTravel pass to be eligible for the scheme.

We have all been busy this week making some ethical crafts for our stall next Friday, and we can't wait to see you there! Have a wonderful weekend!



been amazing, and you truly shone on the day! We are incredibly proud of every one of you **Diolch** to our families for their continued support. Wishing you all a lovely weekend!


