

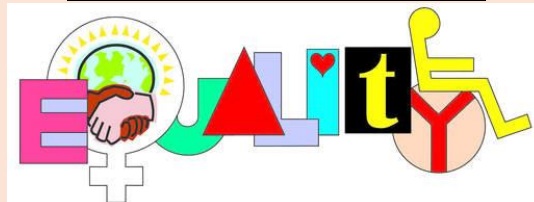

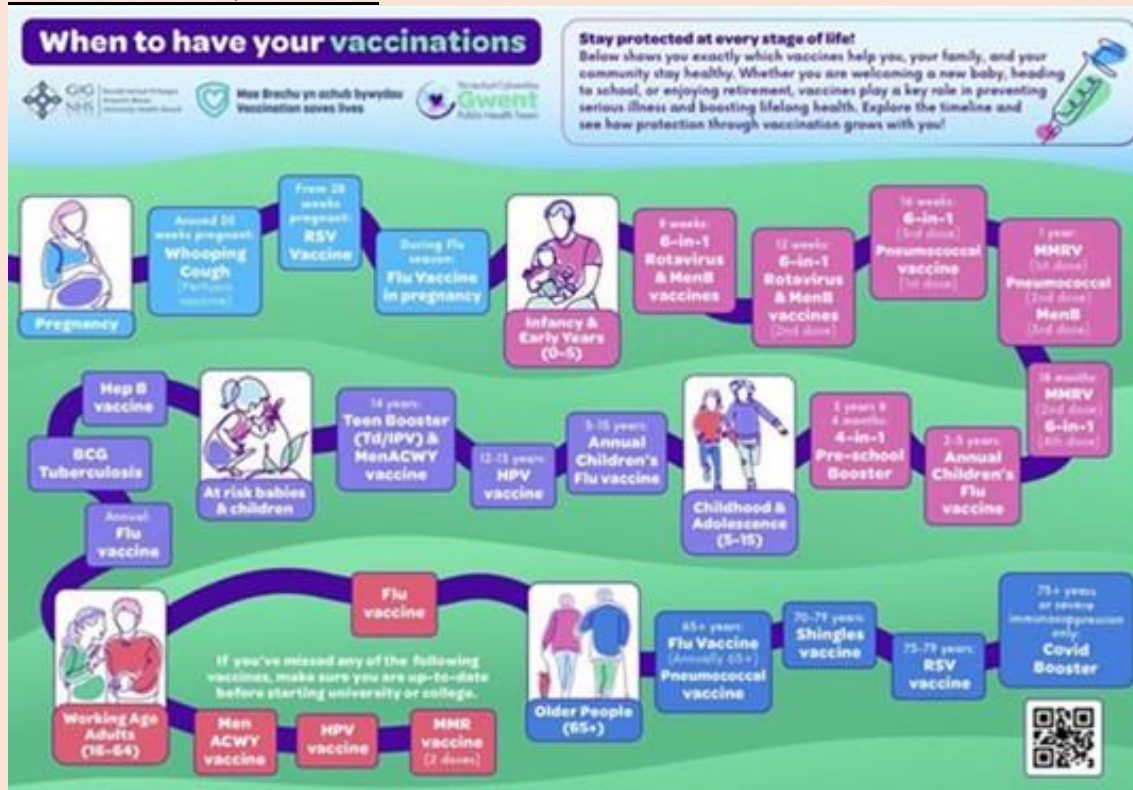
## Parking Notices

## Vaccination Information



Director of Public Health, Professor Tracy Daszkiewicz, is urging parents and carers to make sure children and teenagers are protected against meningitis, following recent tragic cases in Kent

Meningitis can develop very quickly and can be life-threatening. Vaccination is the best way to prevent it.

Key meningitis protection includes:

- MenB for babies and young children
- Pneumococcal vaccine (can also prevent meningitis)
- MenACWY for Year 9 pupils and young people under 25 starting university

**Young children, teenagers and students in shared accommodation are at the highest risk.**

- Check your child's vaccination record by contacting your GP or our Vaccination Service: 0300 303 1373
- Book any missed doses
- Learn the symptoms and seek urgent help if concerned

# Could it be sepsis?

Sepsis is a **life-threatening** condition. It is the immune system's overreaction to an infection or injury.

## Child symptoms

- Are breathing very fast
- Have a 'fit' or convulsion
- Look mottled, bluish, or very pale
- Have a rash that does not fade when you press it
- Are very lethargic or difficult to wake
- Feel abnormally cold to touch

## Adult symptoms

Slurred speech or confusion  
Extreme shivering or muscle pain  
Passing no urine (in a day)  
Severe breathlessness  
It feels like you're going to die  
Skin mottled or discoloured

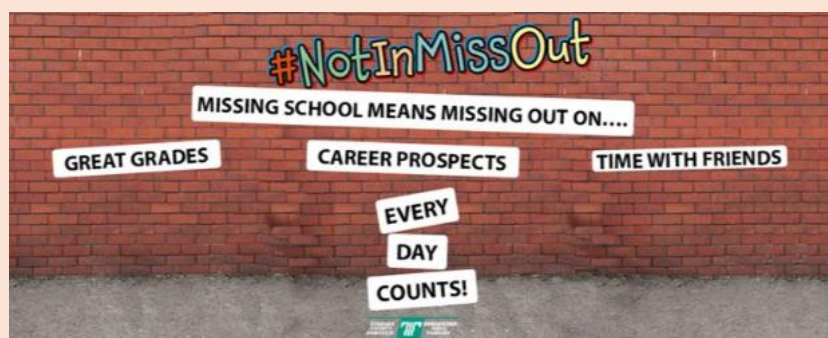
Darker pigmented skin may show colour changes in more lightly pigmented areas, like the inside of the forearm or palms.

## Suspect sepsis?

Seek medical help urgently.

**Call 999** or visit the **Emergency Department at The Grange University Hospital.**

If you're worried about an infection but don't suspect sepsis, call 111.


Dear Parents/Carers,
